#### PROFILE

Dr. Diana Cassie is a Registered Psychologist specializing in Vocational Assessment and Assessments for Verbal and Non-verbal Learning Disabilities (LD) and Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD).

Psychoeducational Assessments focus on the identification of strengths and weaknesses within the individual's learning profile, identifying diagnoses (LD, ADHD, etc.) if appropriate, formulating recommendations given the individuals' learning needs, and providing assistance with identifying and advocating for appropriate services.

Vocational Assessments are conducted for individuals seeking knowledge about what type of careers are appropriate given their vocational skills, vocational interests, and personality variables. Clients for Vocational Assessments include adolescents seeking assistance with subsequent academic choices, individuals seeking new employment options, or individuals who have experienced changes in their vocational profile such as the emergence of physical or cognitive challenges. Recommendations are formulated to help clients identify their next steps. Psychoeducational assessments are also provided for those who seek information about how one's learning profile influences academic and vocational experience.

Dr. Cassie graduated with a B.A. from Wellesley College and with a M.A. and Ph.D. in Counseling Psychology from the University of Toronto. Her clinical training in counselling and assessment were completed both at university and community settings. As well, Dr. Cassie has worked locally at Dalhousie University where she provided counselling, assessment, coaching, and advocacy services to students with LD and/or ADHD. She has also worked as an independent contractor performing assessments at the IWK as well as for independent insurers.
