Is a voluntary professional organization established to represent the needs of psychology professionals. APNS promotes psychology to the public as a profession, as a science, and as a means of promoting human welfare. It offers services to its member psychologists.

NSBEP

Nova Scotia Board of Examiners in Psychology
Ensures that all psychologists in practice in Nova Scotia meet rigorous conditions of training education and supervised practice. Registers Psychologists and Candidate Register Psychologists. Hears complaints from the public relating to the professional conduct of Psychologists. There are 354 Registered Psychologists and 88 Candidates Register
